### Synergizing for Excellence in Nursing Education

Proceedings of the National Conference, 10th-12th Dec 2015, Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University College of Nursing, Pune

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#### Abstract

Synergizing for Excellence in Nursing Education", the national conference was held from Dec 10-12, 2015 at college of nursing, Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University, Pune. Conference was conducted with the intention to increase the values and quality of education in the field of nursing in India. A total of 190 participants pre-registered, including 150 pre-conference registration from all over India and abroad. The participants included chief guest, faculty and students from various nursing colleges. The conference programme was focused on importance of CBCS in nursing education.

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#### Planning Phase

The National conference on "Synergizing for excellence in Nursing Education" was planned under the exemplary guidance of Dr. (Mrs.) Sneha Pitre (Conference Chairperson), Dr. Tapati Bhattacharjee (Conference Advisor). The conference was coordinated by Mrs. Lily Podder as organizing secretary. The speakers' names were suggested by

Several meetings were conducted with faculty members for decision upon the theme, the subthemes, the topics and the date for the conference. The meeting was also held with Dr. A. R. Bhalerao, Dean and Principal, Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Engineering, Pune for the topics to be discussed in conference. The final dates for conference, theme and subtheme were finalized with the consent of faculty members and speakers.

The date decided was from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> December 2015. The registration fee for faculty was decided as 2500/- in case of early registration and 3,000/- for late/on-spot registration. The registration fee for students was decided as 1500/- and 2000/- respectively.

After the final decision regarding the conference, 100 pamphlets were prepared and circulated during Principal's meet at Sawangi Meghe College of Nursing, Wardha Maharashtra on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> July 2015.

Organizing committee members were decided after the discussion with Conference chair-person, conference advisor and conference secretary. The responsibilities of the conference were distributed among all the faculty members, non-teaching staff and M. Sc nursing 1st year students.

Each committee members then started to work for necessary arrangements for the conference. As per the requirements 500 brochures were printed and sent to all the nursing colleges all over India by courier.

**Dr. Mahi Pal**, Director (Planning and Policy), Ministry of Rural development, Govt. of India,

consented to be *the chief guest* for the inauguration ceremony and Mrs. Moumita Sarkar, UN Gender Consultant, Ministry Of Rural Development, Govt. of India, consented to deliver a social note on "Gender Audit" during the conference. Necessary arrangements for the same were done by Dr. Suresh Ray.

Application for awarding CREDIT POINTS to the conference was sent to Maharashtra Nursing Council, which was finally granted to award "4" CREDIT POINTS to the conference delegates and "4+1" **credit points** to the organizers and speakers.

Pre-conference press meet was held on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2015 with presence of Dr. Sneha Pitre, Dr. T Bhattacharjee, Mrs. Nisha Deshpande, Mrs. Minimol Loius and Mrs. Lily Podder at Patrakar Bhawan. The press reporters were given the details of the conference and were also invited to attend the inaugural function. They were also requested for giving the press coverage. Press notes were prepared in English as well as in Marathi and given to the press reporters.

### **Day 1**

The first day of the meeting was started with registration followed by breakfast.
